## The Values of the 'Landlubbers' Holiday Bible Club 2010

**We ask parents and children to refer to the values of the holiday club below and to express agreement with them by signing the appropriate space on the back of the registration form. Please keep this part of the document for your reference. Thank you for your co-operation.**

We want every child who comes to 'Landlubbers' to have a FANTASTIC time because we believe each child is precious to God. In order to help us, please read these values and help your child/ren to understand them.

Our aim is for all the children to enjoy themselves, to build up new friendships and to discover more about Jesus through the various activities.

We want to ensure that everyone is safe and well looked after during the club, therefore the children will be supervised at all times and will not be allowed to leave the site unaccompanied. The Church operates a Child Protection Policy and our leaders have been police checked.

At the 'Landlubbers' Holiday Bible Club we shall expect each child to:

- a. Show respect and to respond positively to reasonable requests from the staff, in the interests of a fun, and safe, environment.
- b. Enjoy working with other children and treat others with care and respect.
- c. Have consideration for school premises and the property of others.

As in previous holiday clubs a coloured card warning system will be in place:

- A 'yellow card' may be shown as a result of negative behaviour. The child/ren will be given space to calm down and a leader will be available to talk and listen to them.
- A 'red card' may be used for persistent or more serious behaviour problems and contact will be made with the parent or carer.

**Data Protection Act:** The Lode Chapel Leadership Team is the Data Controller for the purposes of the Act and personal data may be processed for general church purposes.
